Cutting

Cutting Instructions (WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric)

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A (6244-11 Geofetti Hexis – Bright Multi):

- Fussy cut (21) Large Hexagons.

Fabric B (6235-76 Geofetti Texture – Sea Blue), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Small Hexagon templates.

Fabric C (6237-58 Confetti Onion – Purple Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Medium Hexagon templates.
- See instructions to cut (2) Small Hexagon templates.

Fabric D (1351-Orange Just Color! – Orange), cut:

- See instructions to cut (8) Circle templates.

Fabric E (1351-Teal Just Color! – Teal), cut:

- See instructions to cut (8) Circle templates.

Fabric F (1351-Grass Just Color! – Grass), cut:

- See instructions to cut (8) Circle templates.

Fabric G (6242-78 Lateral Direction – Royal Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Small Hexagon templates.

Fabric H (6239-78 Dimensional Planes – Royal Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Medium Hexagon templates.
- See instructions to cut (2) Small Hexagon templates.

Fabric I (1351-Daffodil Just Color! – Daffodil), cut:

- See instructions to cut (6) Circle templates.

Fabric J (1351-Lipstick Just Color! – Lipstick), cut:

- See instructions to cut (6) Circle templates.

Fabric K (1351-Grape Just Color! – Grape), cut:

- (10) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (8) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Circle templates.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric L (6243-11 Life Savers – Bright Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Small Hexagon templates.

Fabric M (6238-78 Geo Garden – Royal Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Medium Hexagon templates.

Fabric N (6235-83 Geofetti Texture – Flame), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Medium Hexagon templates.

Fabric O (6240-11 Circle Stars – White Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Medium Hexagon templates.

Fabric P (6241-78 Diamonds in the Sky – Royal Multi), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) Medium Hexagon templates.

Fabric Q (6236-78 Geo Flower Power – Royal Multi), cut:

- (4) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (4) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8 ½" x 68 ½" strips.

Fabric R (1351- Pigment White Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:

- (9) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (7) 8 ½" x 50 ½" strips.

Backing (6238-11 Geo Garden – White Multi), cut:

- (2) 88" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 76" x 88" to make the back.

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press (3) Fabric A large hexagons, (2) Fabric B small hexagons, (2) Fabric C medium hexagons, (2) Fabric D circles, (2) Fabric E circles and (2) Fabric F circles onto (1) 8 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric R strip.
- Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make Row One.
- Repeat Steps 3-4 to make Row Two through Row Seven.
- Sew together (8) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric K strips and the (8) pieced rows from Steps 3-4, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to the 50 ½" x 64 ½" Center Block (Fig. 1).

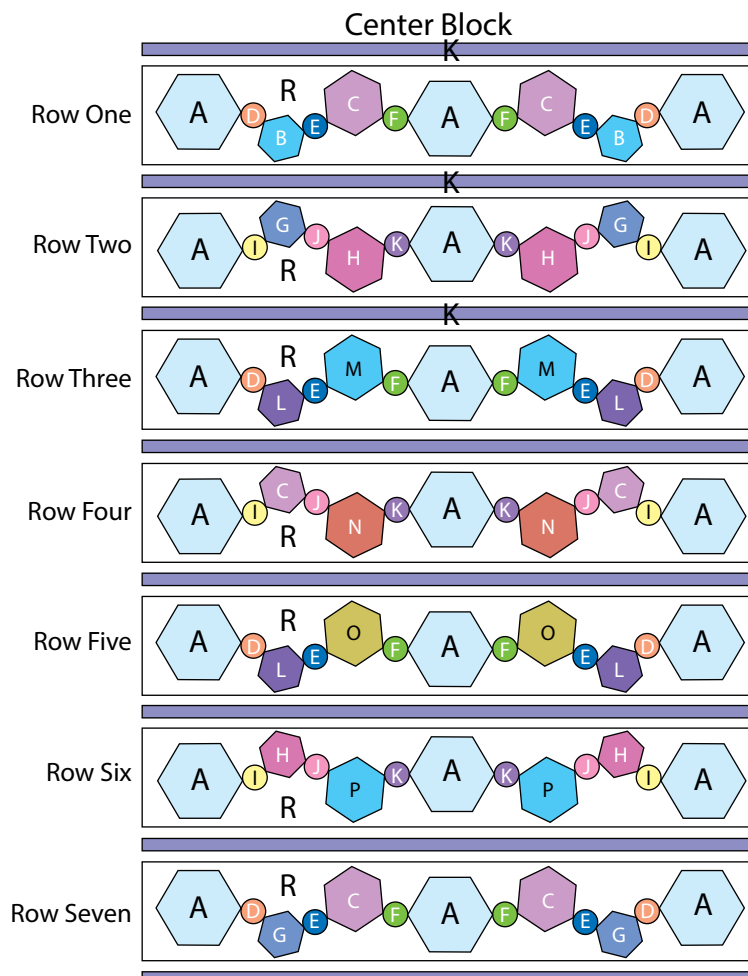

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 8 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric Q strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 8 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric Q strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

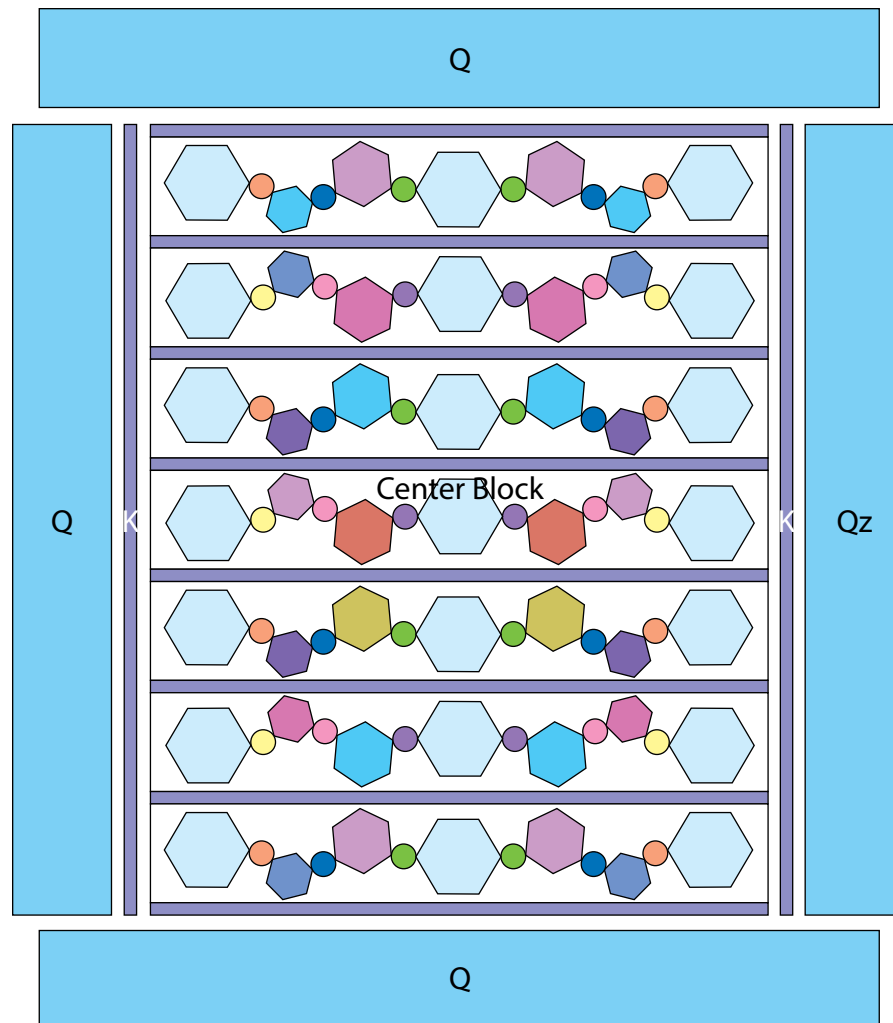
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

9. Press the quilt top and 76" x 88" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

10. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric K binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

11. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

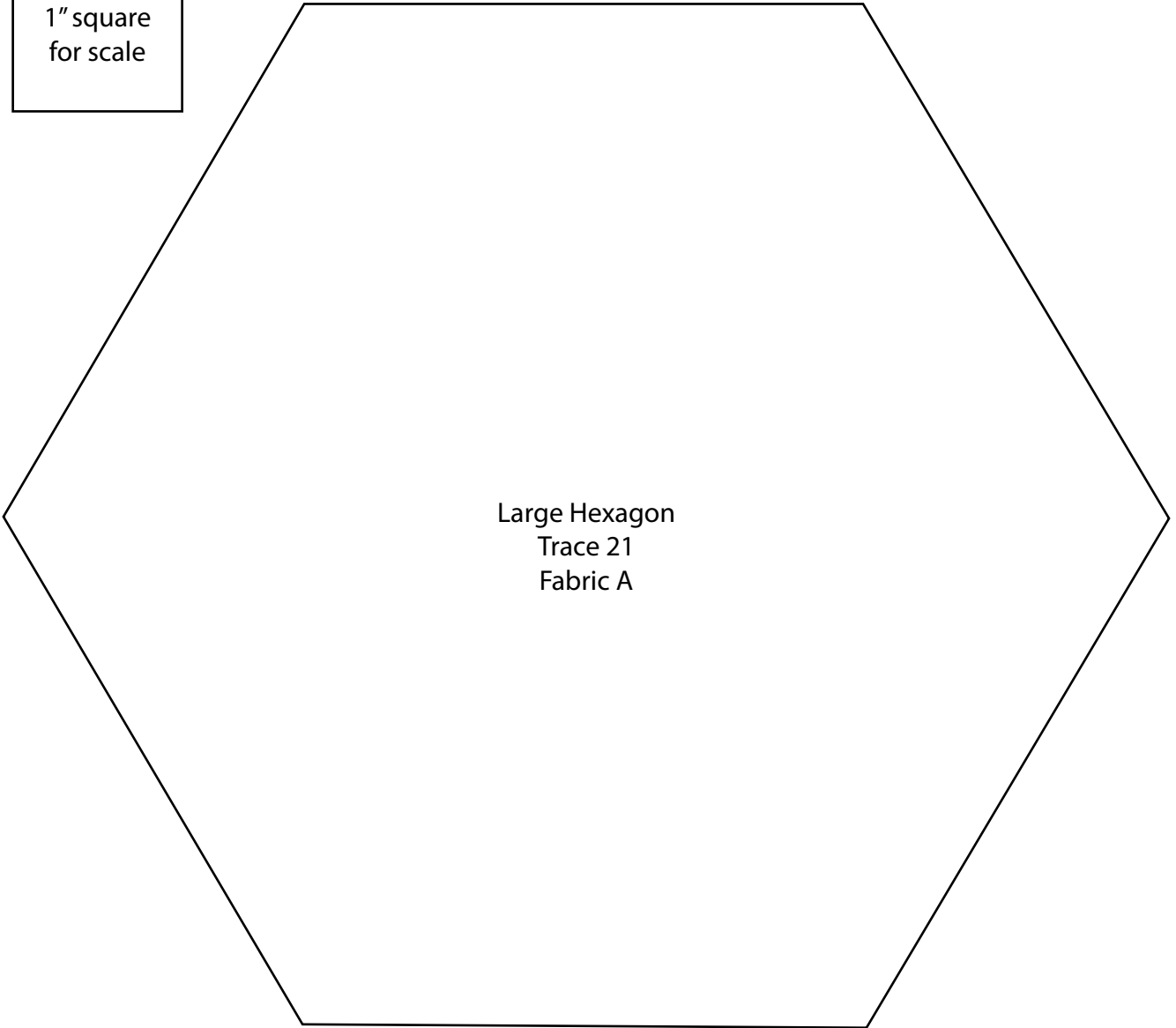


Quilt Layout
